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Changing what we think is possible through 5 simple steps

- 1. Develop students as noticers through inquiry
- 2. Build student identities as authors, teachers, & learners through making books
- 3. Deliberately position students as both teachers and learners creating a sense of agency
- 4. Allow children to be in control of their learning as central to engagement
- 5. Support and encourage children to learn from each other in "dialogic classrooms"

Basic Writing Tenets

- Young children are "already ready" composers and therefore writers.
- Writing is not spelling.
- Writing is thinking...it is composition through pictures, oral language, and approximations of text
