



How to Link to TeachingBooks.net Instructions for Wisconsin Educators

Include TeachingBooks.net among all of your other electronic resources.

- 1) Here's the link to embed into your webpage: <http://teachingbooks.net/enter>
[<http://teachingbooks.net/home> works too, but the former is better in Wisconsin]

This link goes directly to the sign-in page, or it automatically authenticates users if your external IP address range has been given to DPI.

To let people know how to access the site (if they are not automatically authenticated), distribute the bookmark with the "OnWisconsin" password (see reverse).

- 2) Choose the logo that fits your space best:

Horizontal:
