

#### STRESS RELIEF

- your blood pressure by 10%. Studies have found that petting a dog for 15 minutes can lower
- Helps a child relax and unwind while engaging in a beloved activity.
- Improving confidence and academic progress.
- Releasing oxytocin (a feel-good hormone) in both child and dog.

### IMPROVE READING SKILLS

- A 2010 University of California study found that students who read to animals for 15 to 20 minutes per week for eight weeks increased their reading skills by 12% to 20%.
- Another University of California study involving canine reading programs made another increasing by 12% to 30%. exciting discovery. Students participating in a program experienced their reading fluency
- Practice enhancing a story with their voices.
- readers they become more interested in reading and reading at a high level increases a Children spend more time reading when a therapy dog is present. As they become better child's competence
- Increase in the desire to read outside of school.
