Community Service Grant

WSRA encourages councils to apply for a *Community Service Grant* each year. *Community Service Grants* of up to \$200 will be awarded to councils sponsoring community service projects. The grant must be matched by the council with money, materials and/or participation by council members in the project. Each council who applies for a grant and meets the requirements will receive a grant. Grants may be applied for in an amount of up to \$200 and may be reapplied for each year. Grants may be applied for at any time during the year and will be submitted to the council's Zone Coordinator.

Examples of community service projects include: interpretive reading contest, young author's conference, or the donation of new books to hospitals.

Proposals for the grant must include a statement of the purpose of the community service project, its projected outcome, a plan for how the project will be carried out, a budget of how the grant will be spent, how the grant will be matched with council funds, materials and/or participation, and how its effectiveness will be assessed.

Recipients of the *Community Service Grant* will submit an article to the *WSRA Update* describing the project and its results within six months of its implementation or upon its completion.
